PEDESTAL FUEL TANK SELECT SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Connect the Type B USB cable to the USB port located at the back of the Pedestal Type Fuel Tank Select.
2. Next, plug the other end of the cable into the USB port of your computer or a USB hub.
3. Wait for your computer to detect the Pedestal Type Fuel Tank Select device.
4. Configure the device.

OPTIONAL FEATURES OF PEDESTAL FUEL TANK SELECT

1. LED Brightness Control via Desktop Pilot Switch Panel.



The **Pedestal Fuel Tank Selector**'s LED brightness can be adjusted when connected to the **Desktop Pilot Switch Panel**. To enable this feature, follow these steps:

- a. Connect a DC-to-DC cable from the **PDSTL** slot on the **Desktop Pilot Switch Panel** to the DC input slot located on the back of the Pedestal Fuel Tank Selector.
- b. Connect a 5V power supply cable to the **PWR IN** slot on the back of the Switch Panel.
- c. Once connected, adjust the LED brightness of the **Pedestal Fuel Tank Selector** by turning the **PEDESTAL** potentiometer on the Switch Panel — rotate left to dim and right to brighten.

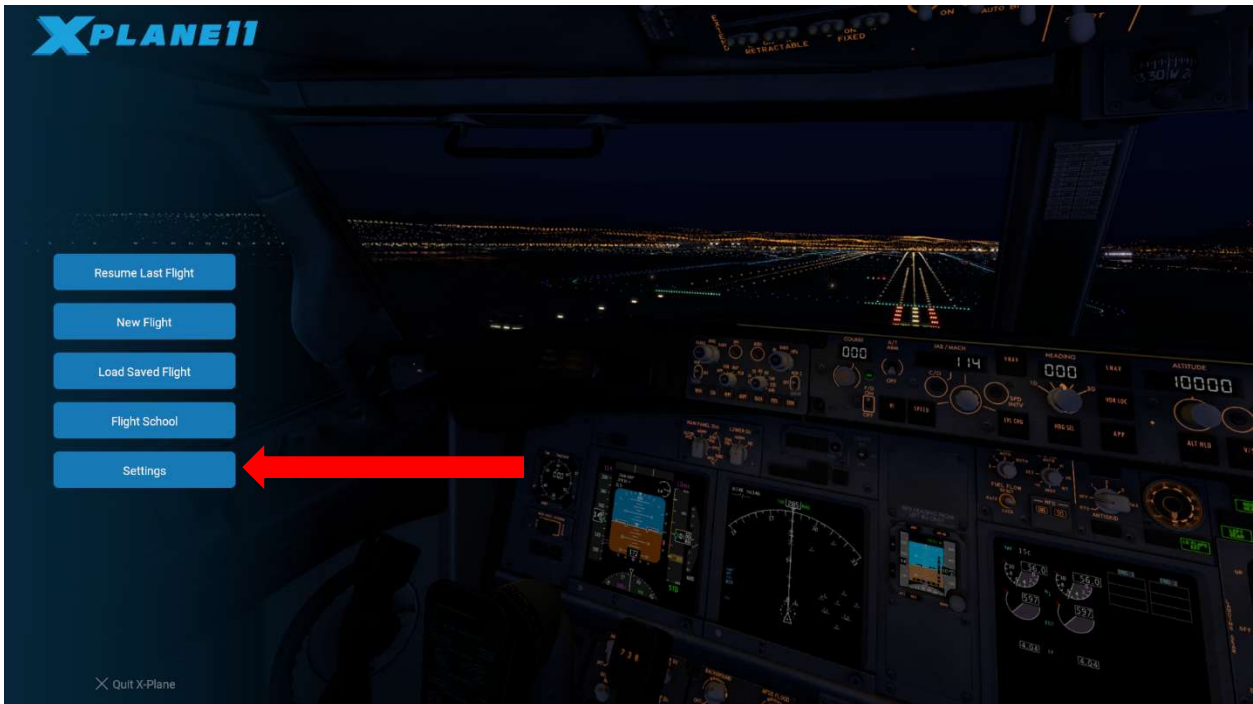

X-PLANE CONFIGURATION

To configure Desktop Pilot's Pedestal Fuel Tank Select with X-Plane, follow these steps:

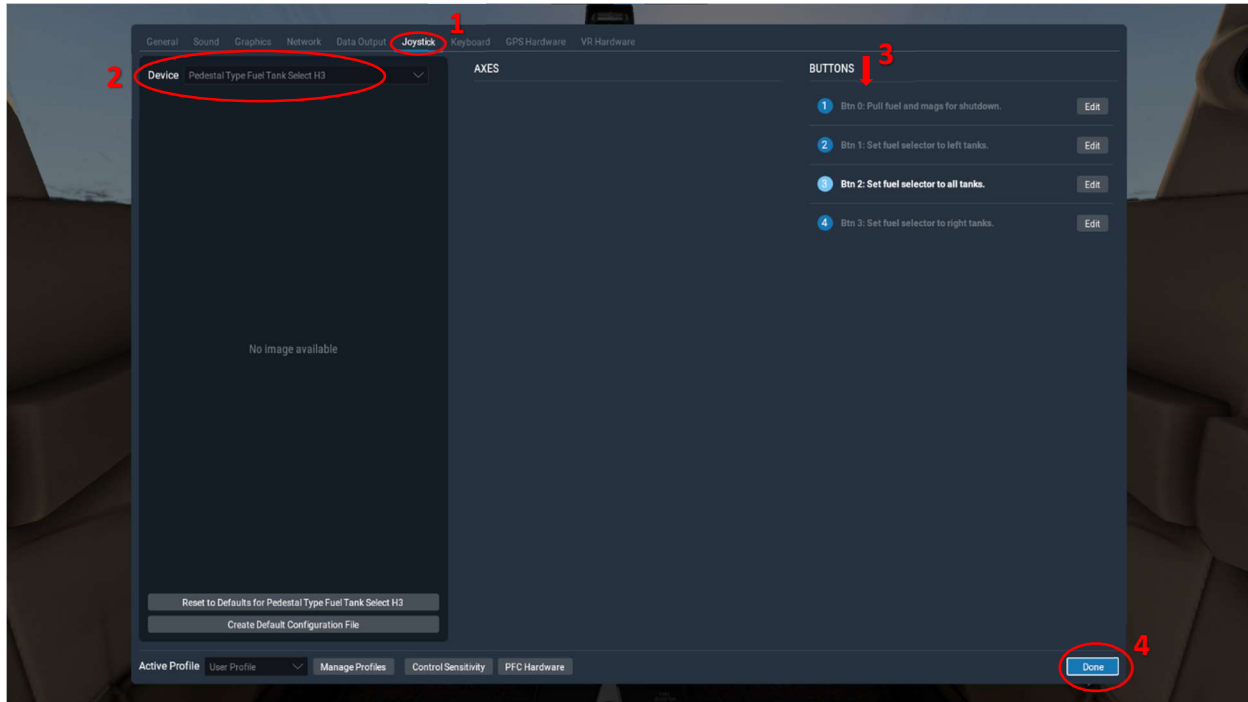
1. Launch X-Plane.
2. Upon launching X-Plane, locate the **Settings**. If you're currently on a flight, hover your mouse cursor at the top of the X-Plane window or screen. Click the button as shown in the picture below to access the X-Plane settings.

3. Open the settings menu and go to **Joystick**, which allows you to configure all the control settings for your devices.
4. Navigate to the “**Devices**” section and select “**Pedestal Type Fuel Tank Select**” from the dropdown menu.



5. Under the "Buttons" section, click the drop down for each button.
 - a. For "Btn 0", search for "Pull fuel and mags for shutdown" and select it.
 - b. For "Btn 1", search for "Set fuel selector to left tanks" and select it.
 - c. For "Btn 2", search for " Set fuel selector to all tanks " and select it.
 - d. For "Btn 3", search for " Set fuel selector to right tanks " and select it.
6. Apply the changes by clicking "Done" when you are finished.
7. Lastly, check to see if the Pedestal Type Fuel Tank Select is working properly in X-Plane.
